2	Will lead an eleven month Drop -In Step Study in 2019 (6pm before the WUIG meeting); led 3 full 15-week series of Step Study workshops in 2018 (workshops were "sold out" each time)*
3	Hosted 6 pre-WUIG meetings this year...attendance ran 4-18 members on various topics (Mens' meeting [2], Sponsorship Training, "Step Zero"--Putting Down the Food, and Getting Through the Holidays Abstinely [2])*
4	Utilizes low cost printing website to ensure we are good stewards of donations from membership (ie., Step Study flyer 1000 copies was less than \$80)
5	Coordinates <i>Loving Cocoon</i> : a group of volunteers who take meetings to homebound OA members; contact Andie our Sponsor Bank Chair to be included or if you know someone who needs a meeting
6	Our intergroup meeting is one of the most well attended meetings in Westchester, averaging 18 members throughout 2018 at each meeting
7	Hosting the Region 6 Convention in 2019; preregistered 359 people during Super Early Bird registration...a record! WUIG will receive \$1000 if the convention is successful
8	Organizes an annual weekend retreat in April*
9	Held two 3-hour workshops this year *
10	Organized one 1/2-day and one full-day marathon of meetings (IDEA Day)*
11	Unity Day workshop*
12	In process of coordinating with key contacts at several medical facilities to try to meet with bariatric medical personel and support staff to introduce OA
13	Publishes a locally written newsletter (the Serenity Times--hard copy & online), maintains website, postbox, telephone information hotline, & provides liability insurance for local meetings (contact our Treasurer)*
14	Placed OA business card ad in placemats in 3 diners for 3 months*
15	Created and printed 4-color fold-over wallet sized Newcomer Cards with slogans, tips, inspiration, and room for telephone numbers and distributed to membership*
16	Supplied OA wallet cards to OA membership to help Carry the Message*
17	Purchased and distributed new OA posters with tear-off tabs to hang in public areas*
18	Funds 2 delegates to vote in group conscience of WSBC*
19	Funds 3 RR to attend two assemblies each year--8 hr mtgs where we do the work of the region which extends from NY to ME into Canada*
20	Fund one working guest to the region assembly (3 yrs now)*
21	Distributes pass through donations (from groups) and & WUIG donations (~\$1000) to WSO & R6
22	Emphasize the importance of Intergroup Reps and Alternates at the monthly WUIG meetings--voice and vote on what is done in OA in our area to help support individual recovery!
23	Jan 3 is our Kick-off meeting from 7:00-8:30 to set our priorities for the year; all are welcome and urged to attend to share their voice*
24	Jan 3 is also the first meeting of our new Anorexic/Bulimic meeting in White Plains from 6-7pm!
